**RE: APPLICATION TO ESTABLISH A NEW TWENTY FOUR (24) BEDDED DAY HOSPITAL
WITH THREE (3) MAJOR THEATRES IN VEREENIGING.**

Your application dated 22 January 2018 has reference

1. In terms of Regulation 7(1) of Government Notice R158 of 1st February 1980 or any amendments thereof, **partial approval** is hereby granted.

The partial approval is as follows:

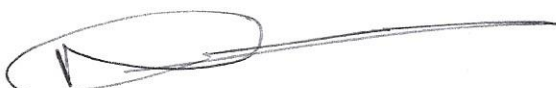
- **Ten (10) Adult Day beds are approved.**
 - **Five (5) Paediatric Day beds are approved.**
 - **One (1) Major Theatre is approved.**
 - **One (1) Minor Theatre is approved.**
 - **The total number of approved Day beds is fifteen (15), instead of twenty four (24) Day beds.**
 - **The total number of approved Theatres is two (2), instead of three (3) Major Theatres.**
2. The above partial approval is based on the accepted norms and classification of a Health Facility as stipulated in R158, and all conditions that will be treated in your Hospital should meet these criteria and failing to conform to the requirements will lead to the application automatically lapsing.
 3. This partial approval is given subject to the Hospital management confirming in writing within the next six (6) months, that the appropriate Human Resources will be available in correct proportions to ensure safety and quality healthcare standards. Such confirmation shall

indicate the number of health professionals in each category available to render the necessary services to the hospital to ensure safety and quality healthcare standards. In this regard you are required to indicate the number and availability of nurses registered with SANC broken down into R.Ns /E.Ns /ENAs in respect of full-time and part-time staff.

4. The partial approval is further subject to the submission of plans in accordance with Regulation 8, 9 and 10 of Government Notice R158 of 1st February 1980 within six (6) months from the date of approval and such plans shall be drawn to the scale of 1:100 and submitted in duplicate.
5. Please be advised that the written proof in terms of points 4 above should be submitted within the stipulated periods of this approval and; if they are not submitted the approval will automatically lapse or be revoked.
6. This partial approval is not transferable in terms of Regulation 7 (3) of Government Notice R 158 of 1st February 1980.
7. The Department of Health must be informed of any change:
 - 7.1 Of ownership
 - 7.2 Of the proposed site if a new building is to be erected
 - 7.3 Of any re-allocation of existing beds that have been approved
 - 7.4 In the shareholding of the company to whom approval was granted
 - 7.5 Of the developer or proprietor of the approved facility
8. Any changes in the information submitted in the application for approval will be considered in terms of Regulation 7 (1) and 7(2) of Government Notice of R158 of 1 February 1980.
9. The **Partial Approval** will automatically lapse if there is no commencement of building operations; and / or proof of continuance thereof; is not furnished after twelve (12) calendar months from the date of approval of the plans.
10. Should you feel aggrieved by this outcome, you may appeal in writing to MEC, Private Bag X 085, Marshalltown, 2107 as provided for in R 158 of 1 February 1980 within seven (7) days of receipt of this letter, failing which this matter will be regarded as closed.
11. Please note that the newly built or refurbished facility may not be utilised before a pre-registration inspection has been carried out by the Department.
12. Kindly note that the partial approval is granted under strict adherence to the R158 and any unintended erroneous application by both parties does not nullify the regulatory requirements and the in principle partial approval.
13. Kindly acknowledge receipt of this partial approval and confirm acceptance of the aforesaid conditions in writing.
